Dear Chairman Conway:

The Maryland Association of Counties testified in support of HB 1067 as a reasonable approach to restoring Highway User Revenues to local jurisdictions. During the hearing, MACo was asked to provide information on the number of road miles by county. This letter is in response to that request.

The attached chart specifies the total highway mileage on state, county, and municipal roadway systems by county. Out of a total of 31,359 road miles, counties are responsible for 21,323 miles and municipalities are responsible for 4,772 miles. Taken together, local jurisdictions are responsible for 83% of the road miles in the State of Maryland.
