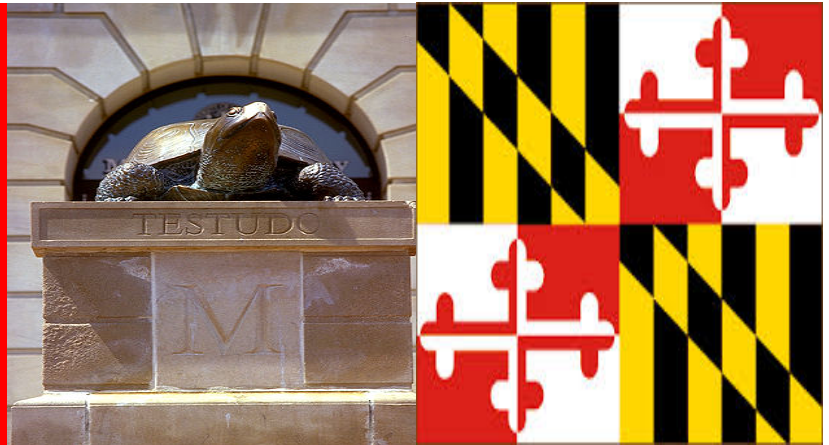

The application deadline is Thursday, December 30, 2015. As it is one integrated program, applicants must be willing to participate in both January sessions. Seats are limited to 25 so early registration is encouraged.
